A LIVING HOPE THROUGH

THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish or fade—kept in heaven for you, who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time. In this you greatly rejoice though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. - 1 Peter 1:3-6

Good Friday demonstrates that God has not abandoned us to our pain. The evils and sufferings that afflict our lives are so real and so significant that God willed to share and endure them. God too is acquainted with grief (Psalm 22). Easter Sunday shows that, in the end, suffering will not triumph. In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials.

It is a matter of time, just wait! God's miracle of transforming a dark, silent Friday into Easter Sunday will someday be enlarged to cosmic scale. - Philip Yancey (*Grace Notes*, p 115)
